TUESDAY

On Tuesday we are praying for our city, county and Nation. The needs of our Nation are huge and we need God to move in our Nation in a new way.

1.Pray for God's kingdom to come

The simplest prayer can be the most powerful: "Your Kingdom Come, Your Will be done, On earth as in heaven"

2. Pray for all in leadership both national and local

Everyone in leadership with local and national government, and those in responsible positions such as Police officers need our prayers.

3. Pray for our city.

Walk around your local streets and pray for the people and places you see.

God of hope, in these times of change, unite our nation and guide our leaders with your wisdom. Give us courage to overcome our fears, and help us to build a future in which all may prosper and share; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen
